

# Lesson Plan: CareerViewXR Scavenger Hunt

## **Grade Level:** 6–8

(Note: If done in groups, this activity could be done in Elementary School levels)

## **Duration:** 45–60 minutes

## **Objective:**

By the end of this lesson, students will:

- Explore and identify local or online companies through CareerViewXR.
- Recognize different industries and types of careers available at these companies.
- Make connections between local businesses and potential career paths.
- Reflect on how companies contribute to their community and the world.

## **Materials Needed:**

- CareerViewXR access (via laptops, tablets, VR headsets, or smartphones)
- A Scavenger Hunt Worksheet (Included with lesson plan)
- Internet Access
- Optional: Projector or smartboard for demonstration

## **Lesson Outline**

### **Introduction (10 min)**

#### **1. Community Connection Discussion:**

- Ask: "What are some companies or businesses in our community that you know about?"

#### **2. Why Career Exploration Matters:**

- Explain how knowing about local companies can help them prepare for the future.

#### **3. Introduce CareerViewXR & Scavenger Hunt:**

- Show how CareerViewXR can help them virtually visit companies they may know or learn about new ones.

### **Activity – Company Scavenger Hunt (30–35 min)**

#### **Instructions:**

- Students will log in to CareerViewXR: web-based experiences or VR headset.
- They will choose 3–5 field trip experiences.
- They will complete their Scavenger Hunt Worksheet during exploration.

#### **Worksheet Prompts:**

- Watch a CareerViewXR video or web-based tour.
- Identify a company within your community (or search online) that has that career.
- Visit that company's website. What do they do?
- What job at any company looked fun or interesting? Why?

## Closure & Reflection (10 min)

### Group Discussion:

- What CareerViewXR video did you watch? What career did you find?
- What company has that career?
- Did you discover a company you didn't know existed in your own community?
- How do these companies help people?

### Exit Ticket:

- Students write one company they want to learn more about and why.

### Assessment:

- Completed Scavenger Hunt Worksheet
- Participation in discussion
- Exit Ticket reflection

### Optional Extension Activities:

- **Community Company Research Project:** Assign students to research a local company and present what they learned.
- **CareerViewXR Showcase:** Students create a poster or digital slide about one company and career from the scavenger hunt.
- **Invite a Guest Speaker** from a local company who has a career featured in CareerViewXR.
- **Tour a local company** that has that career in the CareerViewXR library.
